



2017 Shamrock Shoot



Saturday, March 25nd 10:00AM

The 2017 "St. Patrick's Day" Shamrock Shoot, hosted by Brandeis University Archery Club, is a USA Archery recognized event. It will be shot on one line with practice beginning at 9:00AM. The event consists of an **INDOOR** 70 meter FITA style ranking round consisting of a 720 round (12 ends of 6 arrows) within a four minute period per end for all divisions of Olympic recurve and 50 meter FITA style ranking round consisting of a 720 round (12 ends of 6 arrows) within a four minute period per end for all FITA Compound divisions. This will be followed by a single elimination head to head Olympic round (3 arrow ends in two minutes) for the top 8 archers in each division. It will be shot in the set style (first to 6) format for recurve/barebow shooters and in four ends, top score format for compound. All recurve competitors will shoot at a 122 cm FITA multicolor face. Compound divisions will shoot a 80 cm FITA multicolor face. Barebow division will shoot a 122 cm FITA multicolor face at 60 meters while Collegiate Barebow will compete at 50 meters with the same target.

This Shoot serves as a key fundraiser for the Brandeis University Archery Club and aids the team in purchasing equipment and traveling to events, your support is truly appreciated.

Eligibility and Dress Code

FITA Constitution and Rules as well as USA Archery Dress Code will be in effect and strictly observed for all competitors. All competitors must be members of either USA Archery or NFAA.

Awards

Individual awards will be presented immediately following the conclusion of the competition.

Non-competitors will be able to observe the competition from bleachers behind the shooting line, or from the side of the range in the Multi-Purpose Room, which has windows overlooking the shooting area.

*Please arrive before 9AM as practice will begin promptly at 9:00AM and security will begin limiting access in the field house.

* Foods, drinks and snacks are available for purchased in the field house

Archers younger than the Junior class (18-20) who can safely shoot 50/70 meters may compete in the Junior division.

TO GOSMAN ATHLETIC CENTER:

FROM THE SOUTH

- Rt. 95 NORTH to exit 23-24-25 Mass Pike
Take exit 24 for State Route 30
LEFT of MA-30 W/Commonwealth Ave
First RIGHT onto River Road becomes South Street.
Located one mile on the **right**, *past* the train tracks. Across the street from Brandeis campus

FROM THE NORTH

- Rt. 95 SOUTH to exit 26 onto US-20 W
Merge LEFT on to US-20E
RIGHT turn in 1.2 miles onto South Street
Located one mile on the **left**, *before* the train tracks. Across the street from Brandeis campus

FROM THE WEST

- From Rt. 90/Mass Pike either direction take exit 15 to I-95 N
Take fork towards "North", exit 24 for State Route 30
LEFT on MA-30 W/Commonwealth Ave
First RIGHT onto River Road, becomes South Street.
Located one mile on the **right**, *past* the train tracks. Across the street from Brandeis campus
