



# ARCHERY



<b>CLASSES</b>	Male & Female
BOWMAN	Age 9-12 (will turn 12 yrs old in 2017)
CUB	Age 13-14 (will turn 14 yrs old in 2017)
CADET	Age 15-17 (will turn 17 yrs old in 2017)
JUNIOR	Age 18-20 (will turn 20 yrs old in 2017)
SENIOR/OPEN	Age 21-49
MASTERS	Age 50+, Age 60+, Age 70+

## ELIGIBILITY To be eligible, athletes must meet ONE of the following criteria:

1. A full-time Massachusetts resident for at least 30 days prior to the tournament date.
  2. A full-time student at an academic institution in Massachusetts.
  3. A registered member of an archery club in Massachusetts, for which you are entering. The club must be your exclusive “contact” with the sports. Athletes using the club membership for eligibility may not be a member of a non-Massachusetts club.
- All others may shoot as “Guests”.

**EVENTS** All events will be held outdoors regardless of weather. Athletes may enter ONE event only. Please enter your Event Code & Division on the Entry Form.

## EVENT CODES

AR01	<u>Olympic Bow</u> (Bowman, Cub, Cadet, Junior, Senior/Open, Masters) <i>Recurve bow, pin or aperture sights, any stabilizer, finger release</i>
AR02	<u>FITA Compound Bow</u> (Bowman, Cub, Cadet, Junior, Senior/Open, Masters) <i>Compound bow, any sight, any stabilizer, any release</i>
AR03	<u>Compound Release</u> (Freestyle unlimited, Senior/Open, Masters Only) <i>Compound bow, any sight, any stabilizer, MECHANICAL release</i>
AR04	<u>Compound Fingers</u> (Freestyle limited, Open, Masters Only) <i>Compound bow, any sight, any stabilizer, FINGERS release</i>
AR05	<u>Barebow</u> (Bowman, Cub, Cadet, Junior, Senior/Open, Masters) <i>Compound, longbow or recurve bow, no sights, no stabilizer, any arrow</i>
AR06	<u>Traditional</u> (Senior/Open, Masters) <i>Longbow, Recurve, Crossbow, Wooden Shafts</i>

## FORMAT

**GENERAL** The competition will be held over two days. There is no qualifier required. Distances are measured in meters (m) or yards (yd). Review the formats below carefully. This event will consist of the traditional FITA Round, 36 arrows at 4 distances. In every division, 144 arrows will be shot. Ends will consist of either 6 arrows (longer distances, four minutes) or 3 arrows (shorter distances, two minutes).

**AR01 & AR02** Targets will be USA Archery multi-color, ten ring faces. The 122 cm target will be used for the two longer distances, the 80 cm target will be used for the two shorter distances.

Bowman: Male & Female	30m, 25m, 25m, 20m	
Cub: Male & Female	50m, 40m, 30m, 20m	
Cadet, Masters 50+, 60+, 70+	M: 70m, 60m, 50m, 30m	F: 60m, 50m, 40m, 30m
Junior, Senior, Open	M: 90m, 70m, 50m, 30m	F: 70m, 60m, 50m, 30m

**AR03 & AR04** NFAA style Field Targets 65 cm & 50 cm faces, 5 ring scoring, 36 arrows at each distance. Compound archers should select to shoot these divisions based on personal preference for the distances and target faces.  
Male & female 70yd, 60yd, 50yd, 40yd

<b>AR05</b>	Bowman: Male & Female	30m, 25m, 25m, 20m
	Cub: Male & Female	50m, 40m, 30m, 20m
	Cadet, Junior, Senior, Masters (M&F)	60m, 50m, 40m, 30m
<b>AR06</b>	Distance (male & female)	60m, 50m, 40m, 30m

**NOTES:** A maximum bow weight of 60lbs for event AR02 and a maximum bow weight of 70lbs for events AR03 or AR04. USA Archery dress code applies for events AR01 and AR02. All athletes must supply their own bows, arrows and other related equipment. **Membership to an Archery Association IS NOT REQUIRED, unless applying for a National or World record.**

**DATE:** July 22<sup>nd</sup> & 23<sup>rd</sup> 2017. Bow inspection starts at 8am, with the first practice arrow at 8:30am
