

SAAM 2022 Scholarship Program Out Of State Applicants

The State Archery Association of Massachusetts is pleased to announce its annual Scholarship Program. SAAM is now accepting applications for the 2022 Scholarship Awards.

Requirements:

- Applicant must be a resident of Massachusetts or an active member of a MA archery club and have participated in at least one (1) SAAM sanctioned tournament in the year 2021 * Bay State Games and Indoor Nationals are not SAAM sanctioned tournaments. *. Or provide written description of involvement in a JOAD program along with how you have adapted to training this year as part of the essay.
- Applicant must be accepted to an accredited college, university, or trade school.
- Applicant must be no older than 22 years of age by December 31, 2021
- Applicants may only apply for one (1) scholarship, either the <u>In State Scholarship</u> or the <u>Out of State Scholarship</u>, **not both.**

To Apply:

The applicant must provide the following:

- 1.) A completed essay, which includes answers to the following questions:
 - a. What does archery mean to you?
 - b. How has participation in archery influenced your attitudes and achievements?
 - c. What are your academic and career goals?
 - d. How has your training adapted this past year in regards to restricted access to tournaments and group training?
- 2.) A complete overview of your student information (i.e., current high school/college, grades transcript, extra-curricular activities, etc.).
- 3.) Two letters of recommendation may be submitted separately. (one from your archery coach)
- 4.) A copy of acceptance letter (students already attending college or trade school, please supply a copy of your GPA or grades).

Deadline to submit: the essay and all required information must be postmarked or emailed (pdf file only) by *March 18th, 2022*.
